ENERGY/PIPELINES: Provides for pipelines transporting hydrogen

2	To enact R.S. 19:2(13) and R.S. 30:4(C)(18), relative to the transportation of hydrogen; to
3	provide for the expropriation of property; to provide for authority of the
4	commissioner of conservation; to provide for the issuance of certificates of public
5	necessity; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 19:2(13) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§2. Expropriation by state or certain corporations and limited liability companies
9	Where a price cannot be agreed upon with the owner, any of the following
10	may expropriate needed property:
11	* * *
12	(13) Any domestic or foreign corporation or any partnership composed of
13	such corporations or wholly owned subsidiaries thereof engaged in the piping or
14	marketing of hydrogen. Property located in Louisiana may be so expropriated for
15	the transportation of hydrogen for projects located in Louisiana or in other states or
16	jurisdictions.
17	Section 2. R.S. 30:4(C)(18) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
18	§4. Jurisdiction, duties, and powers of the assistant secretary; rules and regulations

20	C. The commissioner has authority to make, after notice and hearings as
21	provided in this Chapter, any reasonable rules, regulations, and orders that are

necessary from time to time in the proper administration and enforcement of this 2 Chapter, including rules, regulations, or orders for the following purposes: 3 (18) To issue certificates of public convenience and necessity for pipelines transmitting hydrogen. No person shall exercise the right of expropriation under the 5 laws of this state in connection with the construction or operation of such a hydrogen 7 pipeline unless a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the pipeline has been issued. If the project is located in another state or jurisdiction, the 9 commissioner's approval shall consist of confirmation that the applicable regulatory 10 authority of that state or jurisdiction has approved or authorized such project. 11

St. Germain HB No. 998

Abstract: Authorizes the commissioner of conservation to issue certificates of public necessity for hydrogen pipelines and thereby authorizing the expropriation of property for hydrogen pipelines.

Proposed law authorizes the expropriation of property for hydrogen pipelines upon the issuance of a certificate of public necessity by the commissioner of conservation. Such pipelines may transport hydrogen for projects located in or outside Louisiana.
