Application is hereby made on behalf of ENCANA OIL & GAS (USA), INC. for the calling of public hearings, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters:

- To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Holly Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated HOSS RA SU49, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 88-D, effective February 1, 1975, as amended and supplemented by the 88-D Series of Orders, and applicable statewide orders.
- 4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

- Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 88-E, effective August 1, 1975, as amended and supplemented by the 88-E Series of Orders, and applicable statewide orders.
- 4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

- 2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional units all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 88-J, effective July 29, 2008.
- 4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in Holly Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 88-J, effective July 29, 2008.
