Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **GOODRICH PETROLEUM COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, in the Wilmer Field, Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated TMS RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit line and no closer than 660 feet to any well on a competitive unit completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to said reservoir.
4. To provide that horizontal wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforations in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

6. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, in the Wilmer Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,620 feet and 13,043 feet (electric log measurements) in the Oxy USA, Inc. – Richland Plantation A No. 1 Well located in Section 69, Township 1 South, Range 2 East, East Feliciana Parish, and is hereby further defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent section encountered between the depths of 11,692 feet and 12,163 feet (electric log measurements) in the Floyd Williams – Lake Superior Piling Co. No. 1 Well located in Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 8 East, Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana


